## **ADVISORY COMMITTEES – DEFINED**

The two basic types of advisory committees in the Anoka-Hennepin School District are: (I) ad hoc committee and (2) standing committee. The ad hoc committee type of advisory committee is organized to deal with a specific issue. Normally the procedure followed in such a committee is to study the issue in depth, discuss alternatives, and then prepare recommendations concerning the solution of the problem. Once the recommendations have been submitted, the work of the ad hoc committee is complete and it is dissolved. The length of term for each person serving on an ad hoc committee is generally for the entire duration of the committee.

The standing committee is convened for ongoing advisory functions. Tasks assigned to standing committees may deal with advising many aspects of the discipline of a non-crisis nature. Since it is an ongoing committee, terms for members are generally specified and the length is related to the particular task of the committee.
