

# Alligator Pit:

## Greater than and less than numbers 0-9

◎ I can compare numbers by using the words "more" and "less".

Directions:

- Remove Jacks, Queens, and Kings.
- Divide cards into two equal piles.
- Each person has one pile.
- First person chooses a card from his/her pile. Second player chooses a card from his/her pile.
- Two cards are compared. The player with the larger card wins the round and keeps his/her card in a safe place.
- The player with the lower card feeds the alligator his/her card by throwing the card in the pit (on the mat).
- If the cards are equal, both players must feed their card to the alligator.
- If a player draws a joker, he/she gets to steal two cards back from the alligator pit.
- The players are working together to beat the alligator.
- At the end, count how many cards the alligator has and how many the two players have together.

Extension

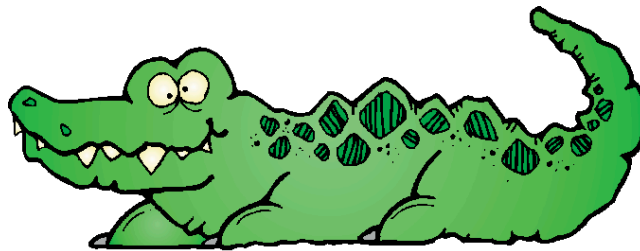
◎ I can add numbers.
