When will I receive my BHS State ACT results?

If you tested through the high school, you will have your score report mailed to the address you provided on the registration form 2 to 8 weeks after ACT receives the tests.

Registering for Future ACT Tests


If you would like to retake the ACT, you can register for the June or July National ACT tests. Registration takes place online and is NOT linked to the paper registration you completed at BHS for the April State ACT test. Unless you created an ACT account prior to the April test you will need to create an account, register, and pay online.

Here are three different scenarios related to online test registration:

Select the method that matches your current ACT account status

1. Registering AFTER I receive my State April ACT score report:

Once you receive your printed score report, you will need to create an ACT student web account using the ACT ID from your score report. See image below to find ID location. DO NOT CREATE an ACT student web account until after you receive your printed score report in the mail.



2. Registering after April test BUT before I receive my score report:

If you are registering for the national June or July ACT test after the April state test and have not yet received your score report-register at <u>actstudent.org</u> as if you have never taken an ACT test before. When prompted, select "No" to both questions below.



3. Already created an ACT national account prior to the April State test:

Register online using your previously created ACT account log-in and ACT ID.

If you test on a national test date, your multiple-choice scores will still be delivered to the address provided on your April state test registration form. ACT will attempt to link the state test results to your prior national test results. This generally occurs after the score reports are mailed home. If they are not able to match the two accounts, you will need to contact ACT directly to link the accounts.

Why do I need an ACT student web account?

- View your scores and score report
- Register to take additional ACT tests (if you choose) or make changes to your registration
- Decide where to have ACT report your scores (post-secondary schools you are considering)
- Update your student profile and view your account history
- Order test preparation materials
