
How to Request ACT Score Reports for a Prior Test

1. Go to website: www.act.org

2. If you took only took the Blaine HS April ACT test in Grade 11, you will need create an online ACT account. Select the click Create US Account button. You will need your ACT ID number (top of Score



Once you are logged in to your ACT account, select the Send Your Scores link


What are the fees?

Inly one test date is reported on a score report. Select the test date you want to report. You will sen be asked to list where you want the scores from that test date reported and pay the total mount due for the Additional Score Reports (ASRs) you request.

4. Next you will see a list of all the schools you previously sent your scores to. Click Continue with Score Report Request




5. If you know the institution's code type it in. If not, type in the name of the college or search by location. Repeat for each college you would like to send scores to.


