# Final Transcripts / Plans for Next Year

Please let us know what your plans are for next year by completing the Naviance Senior Survey PRIOR to Cap and Gown distribution day! The information was provided during CORE and via email!

A question on the survey asks you to indicate if you would like final transcripts sent. Colleges want to make sure that you were issued a high school diploma and require that you send a final transcript.

There is **no fee** to send your final transcript if you have already sent an initial transcript when you applied.

Also, be sure to request transcripts from ARCC, St. Cloud State and/or U of M if you took CIS courses and want them reviewed for credit.
