# How do I apply to the STEAM program?

Students should apply online at **nws.k12.mn.us**. All students (including those assigned to attend AHS) need to apply online.

The 2022-2023 Priority Magnet School Lottery Application opens <u>October 15th.</u>
To receive priority applications, apply by December 31, 2021.

The second round lottery opens January 10 and closes March 11, 2022.

The third round lottery opens March 17 and closes April 15, 2022.
