Dear Families,

We had a fun week learning all about roads and types of transportation! We talked all bout maps, and practiced our counting skills during circle time. We learned about how to care for others during Second Step, and students were able to share how they help their friends with the class.

What did we work on this week?

We continued our Roads & Signs Study this week. Our class read <u>Keep Counting</u> and <u>Discovering Roads</u>. During Second Step, we learned about caring and helping others. We also practiced using our knowledge of roads and signs at the sensory table using road strips, street signs, and tiny cars in rubber mulch to create our own intersection. Each day we talked about words that start with our letter of the week (J), how to write the letter in both uppercase and lowercase, and what sounds it makes. We classified different types of transportation, practiced our writing skills, and identified letters at small group. At the art table, we made a signs collage, and painted with cars. We made a sign, created a stoplight, and made a map at the art table this week.
