In the preschool classroom we model social skills for children. They have many opportunities to practice how to invite others to play. Teachers notice when children invite others to play and might say, "I heard you invite John to play puzzles with you. I can tell he was happy to play with you by the smile on his face!" Children also learn to work together to create play scenarios, work out disagreements, and take turns.

THINGS TO DO AT HOME

- Encourage your child to invite children to play
- Notice and praise your child when they take turns
- Talk about how your child might feel if someone invited them to play. How would they feel if someone wouldn't share with them?
- When playing with your child, ask for a turn with something your child has. If they don't want to give it to you ask if you can have a turn when they are done.
