Happy Thursday! We had another busy week learning all about what to expect in Kindergarten. We talked about what learning will be like, and compared it to what we do every day in preschool.

What did we work on this week?

Our class read If You Take a Mouse to School and Who Will Go to Kindergarten Today? this week. During Second Step, we talked about what learning will be like in Kindergarten. We now have a "making music" sensory activity set up in our sensory table, where students are able to create their own noise makers. At the science table, we now have a color exploration activity, where students are able to mix colors together using transparent shapes and colored liquids. During small group this week, we worked on using number concepts while creating graphs with cars. We also created a rainbow paintings and wind socks at the art table.
