Dear Families,

Happy Thursday! We had an exciting week learning all about boxes. We talked about the different kinds of boxes, and had a discussion about 2D and 3D shapes using boxes as examples.

What did we work on this week?

Our class read <u>Harold and the Purple Crayon</u> this week. During Second Step, we learned about how to manage waiting. We now have kinetic sand with sea shells, small buckets, and shovels set up in our sensory table. Each day we talked about words that start with our letter of the week (M), how to write the letter in both uppercase and lowercase, and what sounds it makes. We now have a science experiment set up at our science table where students are able to be scientists creating a chemical reaction using baking soda and vinegar. We created hidden name watercolor paintings and made box top paintings at the art table. At small group, we learned about shapes using geoboards and practices our letter sounds using sounds tubs at small group.
