Happy Thursday! This we learned all about reusing things rather than throwing them away. We also learned about how feelings can be different for two people, and how some emotions are similar/different.

What did we work on this week?

We continued our Recycling Study this week, focusing on what it means to reuse. Our class read the story Something From Nothing. We also learned that not everybody has the same feelings, and how people can have similar/different interests. We also learned how to write letters with dry-erase markers during circle time, remembering to start each letter at the top. Each day we talked about words that start with our letter of the week (G), how to write the letter in both uppercase and lowercase, and what sounds it makes. We played an alliteration matching game, practiced alphabet letter sounds, and created wood letters at small group. At the art table, we made a family portrait for our portfolios, practiced counting with stamps, and cut paper on various lines.
