4 – year – olds: "I can find the front and back cover of a book."

"I can turn the pages of a book."

When teachers read in the preschool classroom they identify the front cover, the back cover, and other parts of the book. The title, author, and illustrator are identified. Books are read more than once, allowing children to recall what happened in a book they have heard before. Familiar books are available for children in the library area.

THINGS TO DO AT HOME

- Have your child hold the book while you read to them
- Let your child turn the pages in the book
- Discuss the parts of the book; the front cover, the back cover, the pages
- If you are rereading a book see if your child can recognize it by the cover- "What was the title of this story?" "What happened in this book?"
- Talk about the books you read with your child. Ask your child what they liked/didn't like about the book.
