Happy Thursday! I hope everyone has a nice week off from school next week. We are looking forward to seeing you all at conferences! This was a short week of learning about noticing and creating patterns. We also learned about how self-talk can help with focus and emotional regulation.

## What did we work on this week?

Our class read the Three Little Pigs this week. We listened to alphabet songs that help us learn letter sounds. Each day we talked about words that start with our letter of the week (H), how to write the letter in both uppercase and lowercase, and what sounds it makes. We learned about wind science as we pretended to be the Big Bad Wolf and move objects with breath. At the art table, we painted with string and with our hands as we observed what happens when colors are mixed together.

## What will we do next week?
