CREATIVE CURRICULUM FOCUS

Social – Emotional Development:
Regulates Own Emotions and behaviors

Manages Feelings
Follow limits and expectations
Takes care of own needs appropriately

"I can follow the rules in school."

"I can do things by myself."

In our classroom we use the Second Step Curriculum. It is a curriculum that focuses on social skills such as empathy, emotion management, and problem solving. Children are given many opportunities during the day to practice their social skills.

THINGS TO DO AT HOME

- Provide time for your child to complete tasks on his/her own
- Notice and praise your child for their efforts
- Write down household rules, read them to your child, and post them on the refrigerator
- Remind your child about rules as needed
- Notice and praise your child when they are following household rules
- Talk about routines and schedules ("today is a preschool day")
