GROW YOUR OWN

The School of Education partners with school districts and teachers across Minnesota to provide a pathway to teaching for district employees (Tier 1 & 2 teachers/paraprofessionals currently working in Special Education) to become a Tier 3 licensed teacher. Work and Learn offers districts an opportunity to market and recruit candidates into tiered license positions in critical areas of shortages.

Work and Learn provides a pathway for participants to earn their teaching license in special education fully online while working for their district. Candidates from underrepresented backgrounds who reflect our diverse student populations are encouraged to apply. The program provides an affordable, accessible, and accelerated program (34 credits instead of the traditional 47 credits) to earn an Academic and Behavior Strategist (ABS) License and master's degree in 2.5 years. Student teaching can be completed on the job. An additional special education license can easily be added.

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
