Essential Functions:

- Supervise Child Care Assistant staff.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Associates Degree (60 college credits) / Child Development Associate Certificate (CDA); and 1 year (2080 hours) of experience working with children.

Physical Factors include:

<u>Frequent</u>: standing, walking, lifting waist to chest; lifting below waist; carrying, stooping, kneeling, crouching, squatting, twisting/pivot, reaching, simple grasp, firm grasp, fine manipulation; feeling, talking, hearing & visual accommodation;

Occasional: sitting, pushing, pulling, climbing, crawling, and exposure to weather when supervising children during outdoor playtime.
