## **Buildings & Grounds - Maintenance Specialists - Audiovisual / Computer Specialist**

#### **Essential Functions:**

- Audiovisual, computer, and electronic repair.
- Other duties as directed by the Buildings and Grounds Director.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Vocational training and/or significant experience in audiovisual/computer/electronic repair.
- Ability to maintain regular attendance, which includes completing an assigned day.
- Ability to perform position responsibilities including physical factors, work devices and materials handling, data functions, and people functions.
- Must be physically working in the building/on site.

# Maintenance Specialist positions for whom the District requires licensure will receive the following stipend\*:

- Electricians License \$4:30 / hour
- Refrigeration/Universal License \$2.15 / hour
- Master Gas License \$4.30 / hour
- Reduced Pressure Zone State Certification \$2.15 / hour
- DDC HVAC \$4.30 / hour
- Low Voltage Power LTD Tech \$2.15 / hour

There shall be no stacking of licenses; in addition the parties may mutually agree to add addition licenses as may be necessary. \*It is understood that these stipends are not included in the March 1, 1999, though February 28, 2002, total package settlement costs.

### **Physical Factors includes:**

<u>Constant</u>: walking, pushing, stooping, squatting, repetitive arm, simple grasp, hearing, visual accommodation;

<u>Frequent:</u> lifting waist to chest, lifting below waist, pulling, kneeling, twisting, reaching, tasting/smelling, near vision, midrange vision, depth perception, field of vision;

Occasional: standing, sitting, reclining, lifting above shoulders, carrying, climbing, balancing, crouching, repetitive foot, firm grasp, fingering, feeling, talking, far vision.

### Must be able to lift a minimum of 100 pounds.

Occasional to Frequent: lifting, pulling, pushing and carrying materials weighing up to 50 pounds.

Frequent to Constant: lifting, pulling, pushing and carrying materials weighing up to 30 pounds.
