Child Nutrition Assistant

Essential Functions:

- Prepare, cook, and serve nutritionally adequate foods to large groups in a school setting.
- Main areas of responsibility within these positions are: baking, main dish, salad, dish room, and cashier, with assignments rotating among areas as needed.
- Work is performed with others and includes cleaning and sanitizing food preparation areas, dishes, utensils, equipment, and machines.
- Inventory, storage, and some stocking duties are also performed.
- Duties must be performed within federal and state nutritional and sanitation regulations.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age.
- Ability to maintain regular attendance, which includes completing an assigned day.
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 25 pounds.
- Ability to perform position responsibilities including physical factors, work devices and materials handling, data functions, and people functions.
- Must be physically working in the building/on site.

Physical Factors:

<u>Constant</u>: standing, simple and firm grasp, feeling, talking, hearing, tasting/smelling, and visual accommodation:

Frequent: walking, lifting above shoulder, lifting waist to chest, lifting below waist, carrying,

balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, squatting, twisting/pivot, reaching,

repetitive foot and arm movements, and exposure to extreme cold, heat and noise.

Occasional: pushing, pulling, and climbing.
