Andover HS is one of five comprehensive high schools in the Anoka-Hennepin school district. The district also has six middle schools and twenty-four elementary schools, as well as several alternative pro-grams. Anoka Hennepin school district is comprised of 13 north-metro suburban communities; it is the largest district in Minnesota with a total enrollment of approximately 38,000 students.
