Andover is a growing suburban community of over 32,000 residents located north of the Minneapolis-St. Paul metropolitan area. The citizens of Andover enjoy recreational opportunity, quiet neighborhoods, civic involvement and fiscal and environmental stewardship. Andover HS is one of five comprehensive high schools in the Anoka-Hennepin school district. The district also has six middle schools and twenty-four elementary schools, as well as several alternative programs. Anoka Hennepin school district is comprised of 13 north-metro suburban communities; it is the largest district in Minnesota with a total enrollment of approximately 38,000 students.
