Pay Your Fines and Fees


All fines and fees need to be resolved prior to receiving your Cap and Gown on Friday, May 31

ONLY Parents have access through ParentVue - click on "Fee"







Graduation Ceremony Recommendations

Give your personal items to your families (this includes purses).

Consider your choice of **shoes**! You will be standing before the ceremony and walking up ramps AND walking across the stage. We have had <u>many</u> twisted ankles and stumbles due to high heels.

Only cap/gown is allowed to be worn on graduation day.

Exception with American Indian students, who may wear American Indian regalia, tribal regalia, or objects of cultural significance, including feathers and beaded caps.

Do NOT bedazzle your cap! We will exchange with another.

No personalize stoles/sashes! Personalized and customized items will be returned after the ceremony.

Consider hanging your gown a few days to let the wrinkles relax.

Guests will be directed to enter 3M at Mariucci through the Oak Street SE main entrance.


Doors open at 3:00pm for family/friends.

Students entering where the arrows are located directly to seats.

If you have a star (*) on your name card, you are leading the row and will be in the center isle.

You will be in alphanumeric order. Staff will be there to help you get in order before you walk to your seats.

- 11. School Song
 - We will sing the school fight song <u>one last</u> time as the class of 2024 and on the last word of the song: Go *CARDINALS*
- 12. Throw caps (hold on to your tassel!) You may not get your caps back.





Ceremony~ Stage Walk

- 1. You will be directed by staff to stand up
- 2. Follow the person in front of you
- 3. Hand the name card to the person standing at the podium (they will read your name). Names will be called one after the other.
- 4. Walk to center stage to pick up your diploma sleeve
- 5. Walk down the ramp. Shake hands with the people on either side. If you do not want to shake hands, bow your head.
- 6. Head back to your row.

Behavior Expectations During Commencement

Dancing, High Fiving, Yelling, etc can be distracting and take away from someone else's experience.




Receiving your Diploma
