Secretary's Report – Gina Nordeen

*September minutes were reviewed and approved with one change. Under the volunteer report 234 active volunteers should be changed to 34 active volunteers.

Budget Presentation/Vote 2014-2015

*The 2014-2015 budget was approved with the following change: the inclusion of \$100 for the instructional coach. This change brought the approved budget to \$16,456.

*It is possible that taxes may cost less than budgeted this year. We may be able to file a postcard return for \$100-\$150 which shows cash in and cash out. If the long form has to be filed out it will be around the budgeted \$600.

New Requests

*\$500 was approved for use by the 5th grade party committee. The money will be used to buy a tangible item for each 5th grade student as a souvenir of his or her time at Jefferson. Students will receive these items around the time of the 5th grade party.

*Cindy Johnson requested \$160 for two CD disc drives for the 2nd grade. This request was tabled until more information is received on pricing from the district.

Principal's Report – Mark Hansen

- *Jefferson has earned the Reward school ranking based on student growth, proficiency, achievement gap, and graduation rates. The MCA scores for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade are measured.
- *Currently Jefferson staff is participating in ENVOY training. This training focuses on a nonverbal classroom management strategy. The goal is consistency in the classrooms across the building to help preserve the relationships with all students. Staff attends training, meetings, and coaching sessions.
- *Mr. Hansen extended thanks for the planning and carry out of the Jefferson Jaunt.
- *Unity week will begin 10/20. This program raises awareness about bullying.
- *The district is putting in a lap top lab at Jefferson. They are also giving Jefferson additional Chromebooks.

Volunteer Report – Cory Knapp

- *There are 184 applications in and 93 active volunteers.
- *710 volunteer hours are completed.
- *Projects completed are: Jefferson Jaunt, book fair flyers, labeling recorders, copying, laminating, conference food, field trip chaperones, weeding, K skillbuilders, and ESL photo taking.
- *Upcoming opportunities: Hearing and Vision, movie night, hanging Veteran's Day posters, and weeding.

- *The first meeting regarding 5th grade party planning will take place on Monday, 10/20. PTO will provide the insurance and reserve the rooms needed for the party.
- *Discussion about what to purchase for the school continued. Mr. Hansen will look into rough estimates for a sound system for the gym and a new school sign.
