 - O Able to reuse architectural designs from existing schools.
 - O Boundaries will be looked at and shift, more to come.
- 2017/18 Test Score Overview & Priorities
 - O Shared summary of 2016-2017 test scores in reading and math.
 - MAP test is a very good predictor of how kids will do on the MCAs in the spring. MAP test is more dynamic to meet the need of the students. MCA is a high standard test and not dynamic.
 - Welcome to come back to topic of testing anytime.
- Wonder's Curriculum
 - Shared slideshow of information.
 - Focuses on close reading, citing evidence, writing to sources
 - Has been more rigorous, but students have showed more gains. Typically schools experience a dip in student achievement during implementation, actually saw an increase in grade 3.
 - o At home
 - Look at that weeks story with them.
 - Related games and activities.
 - Some teachers assign things in wonders.
 - Can see test scores. Tests are harder.
 - O Wonderworks students that work with Special Ed.
 - Wonder ELD Supplemental/EL teachers use these.
