  - Snack bags went really well
  - Thank you given to teachers
  - Incentives levels made good additions and incentives. They have all been distributed!
    - Feedback that incentive did keep kids excited.
  - o 3 different money counts, would recommend doing it again.
    - Also recommend having at least one consistent volunteer to help coach other volunteers in counting process.
  - Kept 97% of total dollars donated between in person and online donations, and with \$2.50 donations to offset online costs
  - Total amount of money donated: \$22,674
  - Total supply/prize donation value: \$1102
  - Expenses: \$850
  - 51% participation overall
  - 14% participation online
  - o 9 classrooms met their goal have been given supplies for popcorn party
  - The ending program went really well.
    - 44 students participated (46 students eligible) being in Minute to Win It
