  - Focusing on Quality Compensation (Q Comp) a structure for job-embedded professional development that provides incentives for teachers to increase their skills as educators by positively impacting student achievement.
  - WonderWorks Personalized, flexible, and intensive intervention program for struggling readers in grades K-5.
  - Title I federally funded program that focuses on improving the academic achievement of the disadvantaged. Schools are required to have a parent involvement plan that includes family education, meetings, and communication.
