Based on a comprehensive review conducted by Dr. Karen Rogers of the University of St. Thomas, it was recommended to "upscale" the identification process, including the ability to measure non-performing high potential learners.

The CogAT 7 (Cognitive Abilities Test) will now be used for all 2nd graders. This test is a nationally standardized, norm-referenced test that is used in over 80 MN districts. The test measures reasoning and problem solving in 3 areas:

- 1. Verbal
- 2. Quantitative
- 3. Non-verbal

The test results will be shared with families and will be used with other assessments to determine proper educational placement for students.

Next Steps:

- Continue looking at other district programs and feedback
- Continue development of recommendations for ELA and Math (emphasis on grades 3 5)
