Special Topic - Middle School Transition - Julie Klund-Schubert, AP at Northdale Middle School

- Daily schedule, 8:25-3:05, 7 period day.
- 4 minutes of passing time. It may not seem like much, but they will get it by the end of September.
- Middle school has 2 digital days (instead of 5 like elementary school).
- Students have their own locker and physical education locker. Good to have them practice using combination locks over the summer.
- 6th grade
 - English Language Arts (ELA) for 2 periods
 - Math
 - Science
 - Minnesota Studies
 - Art/Health every other day
 - Music/Physical Education every other day
- Supporting your child
 - Planner/agenda book
 - Online access to gradebook for parents and students
 - Plan for 45-60 minutes of homework each night
 - Independent reading
 - band or orchestra practice
 - math homework
 - Work in science, MN studies, and health
- Grading in middle school
 - Students are graded on their mastery of the learning targets in each course.
 - Each course has end of trimester summative assessments worth 10% of the trimester grade
 - Throughout each trimester teachers give several formative and summative assignments.

 - Activity busses Monday-Thursday at 5:10pm, also Monday and Wednesday at 4:10pm
 - Community Education has sports, clubs, and other opportunities

- Staff did more ENVOY training before break. This is our 3rd year working with this training.
- Cats and Dogs training strategies for working with individual students that are challenging.
- Kindergarten registration is on April 3rd, 6-7pm. Will be more about open house format.
- MCA testing the change is that the testing will be in the classroom this year. Starting with reading for 3 days, a week off, math for 3 days, a week off, then 5th grade has science.
 - MCA scores can be accessed online through AH Connect. Release of the scores depends on the state. Last year it was August.
 - MCA testing helps to inform what kinds of classes would be best for them in middle school.
