#### Principal Report - Mr. Hansen, Principal

- Fit for the Future Update
  - o Flyers and display for the upcoming referendum vote were available
  - Showed a video summary
  - O Did a slideshow overview of Anoka Hennepin
    - AH is spending 3% more in the classroom than state average
    - State revenue is main funding source, 17% from property taxes
    - If passed, the average tax increase (for a \$200,000 property) would be \$11/month
    - Funding generated will create safe and secure learning environments, space for growing student populations, maintain quality schools, and address class size.

#### Kindergarten Teacher Presentation - Jessica Wegener

- Kindergarten Teacher Introductions
- Overview of Kindergarten Areas of Focus
  - O Routines and expectations many have never been in a school setting, have been helping them learn. Learning to follow schedule, visual schedule posted. Practicing lining up, stand in line, work at tables. Learning rules for different areas.
  - Communication most have take home folders, will contain communication from school and teacher, including regular classroom update (peek of the week, etc.). Please unload child's folder daily or weekly. A note in the folder, email, or voicemail is great for communication.
  - O Specials K attends music, art, phy ed, explorations, and core support.
  - Reading curriculum Wonders 2 year, has a lot of movement and music. Smart start, goal is to learn all the letter names. Working on rhyming and writing names.
  - O At home help foster independence: Let them pack their own backpack, snack, etc. Have them practice getting own winter gear on!
  - Math Teach calendar as a way to teach counting forward, recognizing pattern, etc. Work on counting to 10, recognizing dot patterns, notice numbers in the community, sort shapes and colors, and play games that move spaces. Working on shapes.
  - O Lunch PINs Practice at home, it will help lunch lines go faster.
- Question about Eating
  - O Breakfast not required, they are asked if they want to go, but they are not automatically brought.
