- U of M record in 33 seasons(1986-2018): 1,164 wins and 780 losses (.599)

- 9 Big Ten Championships; 8 Big Ten Tournament Championships
- Finished 1st or 2nd 20 times in 33 seasons in the Big 10
- 17 NCAA Tournament appearances
- 2008 ABCA National Assistant Coach of the Year
- 2018 MHSBCA Hall of Fame inductee
