Now that you've submitted college applications, your next step is to complete the FAFSA. This application can be completed online using your 2020 income taxes. **2022-23 FAFSA FORMS OPEN OCTOBER 1, 2021**

Attend our FAFSA help event to get free, on-site professional assistance completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Families will hear a FAFSA presentation outlining steps and tips to complete their FAFSA before having time to work and have their questions answered. Registration is not required for this event.

**Steps to complete before the event:**

- Apply for your FSA ID number prior to attending at <https://fsaid.ed.gov>

**Bring the documents needed to complete FAFSA**

- Your Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (**Note:** You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign electronically.
