

The President's Volunteer Service Award

The President's Volunteer Service Award was created to recognize the tens of millions of Americans who have made a sustained commitment to volunteer service.

Champlin Park High School makes this award available to the students who complete the required service hours over the course of a 12 month period which is January 1, 2018 – December 31, 2018.

To earn the award, students must submit their volunteer records for review and verification. Activities should be unpaid and may not include court ordered community service or service while incarcerated. Service hours from mission trips or camps can not include sleeping, travel or recreation time.

Recipients receive:

- An official President's Volunteer Service Award pin
- A personalized certificate of achievement
- A note of congratulations from the President of the United States
