- 4. February 2: Hypothesis paper is due. This explains what you think will happen in your experiment before the experiment is finished. It is an educated guess.
- 5. February 8: Turn in a paper with a list of all the materials used in the experiment.
- 6. February 15: Procedure paper due. This is a paper explaining how you did your experiment.
- 7. February 22: Conclusion paper is due. This gives a summary of how the experiment turned out.
- 8. February 17-24: Put project together on presentation boards.
- 9. Feb. 25: Projects brought to school. Class demonstrations will begin on 2/28 and finish on 3/7.
- 10. March 8: Parents are welcome to view the projects in the classrooms from 1:45-3:15 p.m.
