What To Watch For:	<p>This course focuses on analysis of literature (stories, books, plays, poetry, etc.) and informational text (articles, newspaper columns, editorials, commercials, etc.). Practice and simple homework assignments near the beginning and middle of the term may not be worth many points, but they help teach and support skills needed for the major assignments later in the term.</p> <p>Major assignments are typically given at least 1 week in advance of the due date. To produce their best possible work and to decrease last-minute stress, students are encouraged not to procrastinate on major assignments.</p> <p>Reading, writing, presentation, and discussion participation will all be significant elements of the final grade. Honors English 10 will have an <u>extra</u> emphasis on revision and editing of writing.</p> <p>Computer and internet access will be helpful for this course. Computer access is available in the Language Arts Resource Center (LARC) before and after school on most days, and in the Lighthouse after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays.</p>
