$$(\sqrt{2x-5})^2 = (-3)^2$$

$$2x-5 = 9$$

$$-3\sqrt[3]{2x+1} - 4 = 11$$

$$\frac{-3\sqrt[3]{2x+1}}{-3} = \frac{15}{-3}$$

$$(\sqrt[3]{2x+1})^3 = (-5)^3$$

$$2x+1 = -125$$

$$\frac{2x}{2} = \frac{-124}{2}$$

$$x = -62$$

$$(\sqrt[4]{3x-1})^4 = (\sqrt[4]{x+9})^4$$

$$3x-1 = x+9$$

$$-x \quad -x$$

$$2x-1 = 9$$

$$+1 \quad +1$$

$$\frac{2x}{2} = \frac{10}{2}$$

$$x = 5$$

$$\sqrt[4]{3x-1} = \sqrt[4]{5+9}$$

$$\sqrt[4]{14} = \sqrt[4]{14}$$
