

# ACTIVITY 10

## Tracing the Alphabet Book

### **PURPOSE:**

Learning the names of each upper and lowercase letter of the alphabet.

### **SUPPLIES:**

Alphabet book

### **GOAL:**

To teach the name of each letter, and create a link to the letter sound by identifying a picture.

### **TIMELINE:**

This activity continues until student is able to name 40 letters or more, as determined by the classroom teacher.

### **PROCEDURE:**

1. Sit next to the student.
2. Teach the student to use his/her pointer finger to trace each upper and lowercase letter in the alphabet book, and say: "A, a."
3. Next the student points to the picture and says: "apple".  
(ex. A, a, apple B, b, ball.... and continue through the alphabet book)

**Note:** *If the student does not know the letter name, say it for him/her and have the student repeat the letter name while tracing it.*

**Note:** *If the student needs help with letter formation, guide his/her hand in tracing the letter correctly, following the direction of the arrow accompanying the letters.*

**Note:** *If the student does not know the concept of the picture, explain the concept and have the student repeat the picture.*

**Note:** *If the student knows less than 10 letter names, have the student trace only the letters in their name, with any other known letters.*
