ACTIVITY 8

Letter Sounds

PURPOSE:

To build automaticity with known letters.

SUPPLIES:

Magnetic Letters (6-8) - in pouch Alphabet Chart - in binder

GOAL:

All kindergarten students will identify letter sounds, with accuracy and fluency.

TIMELINE:

This activity begins once students are able to identify the beginning sounds in words fluently.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Place letters in a line in front of the student.
- 2. Say: "Listen to the sound that each of these letters make." Volunteer points to each letter and makes the letter sound.
- 3. Say: "Find the letter that says, /b/ pronounced "buh."
 - a. Student points to the letter and repeats the letter sound.
- 4. Repeat activity with 5-6 different letter sounds.

Note: Continue by changing the groups of letters. Students continue this activity until they can quickly say letter sounds for all letters of the alphabet.
