
## How to volunteer with Anoka-Hennepin Schools

Thank you for your interest in volunteering with Anoka-Hennepin Schools. To become a volunteer you must complete both a volunteer application and a Criminal Record History Release (CRHR) for each school you would like to volunteer at every school year.

Step 1: Visit ahschools.us/volunteer or scan QR Code

Step 2: Click on the link of the school where you would like to volunteer





If you are a new volunteer in our district, fill out the fields in the box that says "I am new to MyImpactPage.com." If you have volunteered in the district in the past, type in your username and password in the fields in the box that says "I already have a username." Click the button to continue.

Once you have completed the volunteer application and CRHR, the school's Volunteer Services Coordinator will send you an email to confirm you are an approved volunteer. Some activities such as field trips, tutoring, or handling money (among other things) may require additional processing and approvals, which can take up to two weeks.
