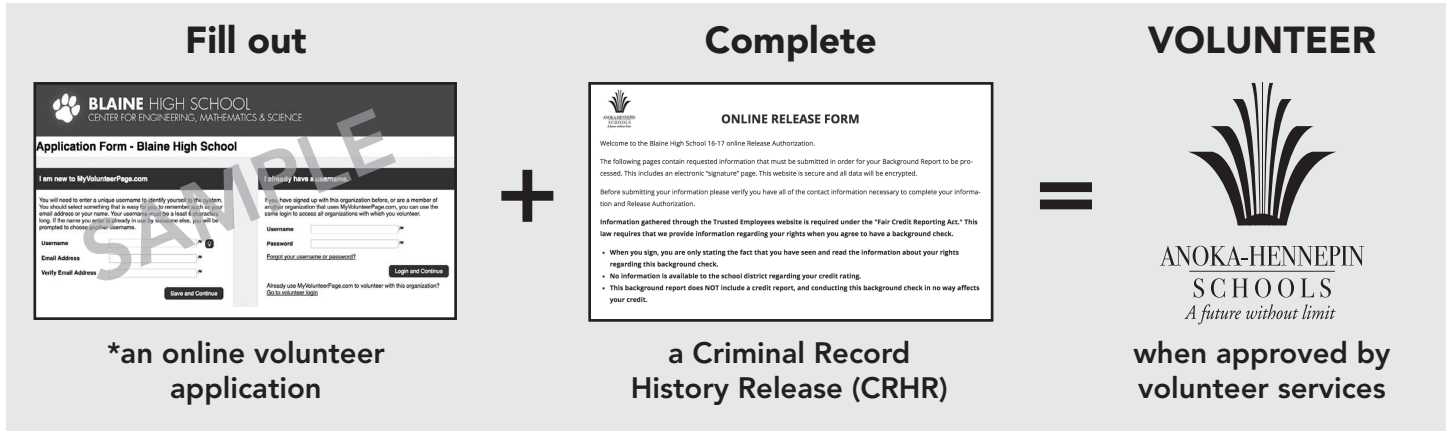


How to Volunteer with Anoka-Hennepin Schools

***You must complete a volunteer application and Criminal Record History Release (CRHR) each year for each school you would like to volunteer.**



1. Visit ahschools.us/volunteer.
2. Click on the link of the school where you want to volunteer.
3. On the right side of the page, click the **volunteer application** link.
4. On the right side of the page, click **Fill in an application**.
5. **New users:** On the left side of the page you will see "I am new to MyVolunteerPage.com." Create a Username and enter your email address. We recommend using your email address for your username. Click "Save and Continue." You have created your Volunteer Account.
Returning users: Under "I already have a username" enter the username and password you have previously created. Click "Login and Continue." (Click "Forgot your username and password" if you don't remember one or both.)
6. Create or update your profile by completing the information about your interests as a volunteer. Click "Submit the application".
7. Once your application has been submitted, you will be prompted to complete a **Criminal Record History Release (CRHR)**.
8. Once you have completed the **volunteer application** and **CRHR**, a volunteer services staff member will send you an email letting you know you are approved to begin volunteering.

If you would like to volunteer at an additional school, repeat steps 1-4. From that point, enter your username and password information under "I already have a username." Complete the application and CRHR for each additional school.
