### PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Ribbon skirts and shirts are historical and traditional clothing that honor heritage and express Native pride. Ribbon work can be seen historically throughout the Plains and Great Lakes communities starting in the 18th century, when ribbons were introduced through trade.

Considered an expression of history, resilience, and character, ribbon shirts and skirts are not only seen at ceremonies and powwows, but also at other special events and gatherings. Ribbon clothing can be subtle or showy and almost always have a touch of personal expression and tribal tradition.

Join us for a one day class where you can learn the basics to construct your own ribbon skirt or shirt!

- Ribbon, Fabric, etc. provided; If you would like to buy your own fabric we recommended: Skirts - 1 1/3 yards of fabric; Shirts - 3 1/2 yards.
- Students under 15 must have an adult with them.
