LOW COST INTERNET OPTIONS

For families in need of low cost internet, and who have one or more children participating in the National School Lunch Program, Comcast and CenturyLink both offer programs.

COMCAST

If you have at least one child eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program, or if your family qualifies for public or U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) assistance, your family may qualify for fast, affordable home Internet service for the new school year. Comcast's Internet Essentials costs just \$9.95 per month (plus tax). For participating families, there are no price increases, no activation fees or equipment rental fees.

In addition, you can buy a low cost computer for just \$149.99 (plus tax) and receive free internet training — online, in print and in person.

If you think this might be right for your family, it's easy to get started. Visit www.InternetEssentials.com to learn more and see if you qualify, or call 1-855-8-INTERNET (1-855-846-8376) to enroll and get connected.

CENTURYLINK

Having the internet at home makes all the difference — in work, at school and connecting with others. Now you can bring the benefits of the internet home to your family for only \$9.95 a month.

Qualifying low-income households can get internet up to 1.5 MBPS for \$9.95 a month with a 12-month term commitment plus taxes and fees.

In addition, families can get an iPad mini 2, valued at \$150, plus taxes and fees. It's available at enrollment with a 24-month commitment to CenturyLink high speed internet.

Also included is free basic internet training.

EveryoneOn.org works with a network of internet service providers and computer refurbishers to provide affordable ways for U.S. residents to get online.

They offer internet access for as little as \$10 a month; routers and modems from \$25 and up, plus taxes and shipping; and laptops and tablets.
