VOICEMAIL SYSTEM

FIRST THINGS FIRST:

Setting up your account for the first time:

- 1. Dial 67800 from school (or 506-7800 from outside the district).
- At the first prompt (*Call Pilot from Nortel Networks, Mailbox?*), enter YOUR voicemail number (XXXXX), then #.
- 3. At the next prompt (*Password?*), enter your password (35 XXXXX), then #.
- 4. Press 84 and follow prompts to change your password (at least 6 digits). "Old Password" is the one you just got in with.
- To record your greeting, press 821 and follow prompts. Press 5 to begin recording, and # to end recording. Don't forget to add, "*if you need immediate assistance, please press zero*". Press 2 to review your greeting.
- 6. To record your name, dial 829 and follow prompts.

POLICIES and GUIDELINES:

- \checkmark ALWAYS record a greeting (821) and record your name (829).
- ✓ ALWAYS change your initial password (84) to a unique password (at least 6 characters).
- ✓ ALWAYS include "*dial zero for immediate assistance*" when you record your greeting.
- ✓ CHANGE your greeting if you are going to be away from the office (823).
- ✓ CHECK your voicemail daily.
- ✓ Contact people who leave messages within one working day.
- ✓ DON'T activate your phantom number to ring in your classroom during student contact times.
- ✓ ALWAYS dial 10 digits to ensure caller ID is correct (even in the 763 area code)
