### **Goal:**

To come up with an Artistic Vision and Design Concepts for the musical *Once On This Island JR*.

**Steps of Project:** *Once On This Island JR* out loud as a class.

1. As you read, think about how you would want to design the costumes, lights, sets, and make up/hair. I encourage you to take notes of your ideas as you read.
2. After we finish the play you will be divided into groups of four, which will become the Design Teams.
3. Your group must put together a **minimum** of a 10-minute presentation that you will present to the class. It must answer the below questions and **use** visual aids.
4. Once in your groups, decide who will be considered the following designers: Light Designer, Set Designer, Costumes, and Hair/Make Up Designer. Even though one person is the primary person in that design job, **ALL** of the group should share ideas and on each subject. As a team you will need to address the challenges of the play.
5. Your presentation must be able to answer the following questions and can use a mixture of power points, renderings, models, full-scale examples or other visuals...
  - What is the form of this show? (i.e. comedy, drama...)
  - What is the play's Super Objective?
  - What moment is the Climax of the play?
  - What is the theme of the play?
  - What is the overall look of the show (the Artistic Vision)?
  - What kind of stage would you do the show on (Proscenium, Thrust, Round or Black Box)?
  - What do the costumes look like (provide visuals of at least three of the costumes)?
  - What does the hair/make up look like (provide visuals of at least three of the characters)?
  - What do the sets look like (provide a rendering/model of at least two sets)? Are they big sets or small sets? How many sets would there be?
  - What does the lights look like (provide visuals of at least three of the scenes)?
