### THE PROJECT:

Each group is assigned a ten-minute professionally written script (from the Actors Theatre of Louisville), which they are to then rehearse, memorize, design, provide props, provide costumes, provide set pieces and ultimately perform the play in front of their classmates.

### THE GUIDELINES:

- You must decide on and find any costumes, props or set pieces that you might need.
- Everything must be presented in a realistic manner with movement, action and fully realized characters. Do not just stand and recite the script.
- You must be memorized.
- Be prepared to perform your piece on its due date.
- You will have time in class to work, however you will <u>need</u> to plan to finish some aspects of the project on your own time.

## THE GRADING:

- Each group member will receive an individual grade based on her/his work and dedication to the project. This means some people in the group could get a low grade while others receive a high grade.
- You will be asked to provide input about your team members; letting me know how well they participated and how much work they did on the project.
- You must follow all the guidelines to receive a good grade.
- You must show that you have worked hard and put forth <u>a lot</u> of effort to receive a good grade on this final project.
