

Radio Show Project Goal: To produce and record an "old time" radio program.

Requirements:

- 1. You will be divided up into three even groups.
- 2. As a group, brainstorm and decide on a story idea.
- 3. Divide into writers, actors and sound effects people (some of you may have to do more than one task or may want to do more than one task).
- 4. You will be graded on how well you use your IN CLASS work time.
- 5. Write the script, which must be between 10-15 minutes long (that works out to be about 10-15 typed pages). The script can be typed or hand written. I can make photocopies of your scripts for your whole group.
- 6. The script should follow a story line with super objectives and conflict.
- 7. Gather sound effects.
- 8. Be well rehearsed!
- 9. Actors should create voices that are appropriate to her/his characters. If an actor plays more than one role they should have a VERY different voice for EACH character.
- 10. Work on clear articulation and enunciation (avoid popping consonance.)
- 11. Make certain that you have timed your script so that it is the required length (10-15 minutes).
- 12. You will present your shows to the class as if it *were a live radio* broadcast!

After everyone has recorded their shows we will sit around the radio and listen, just like the old days!
