Clean up after yourself, keep the classroom & materials in good shape.

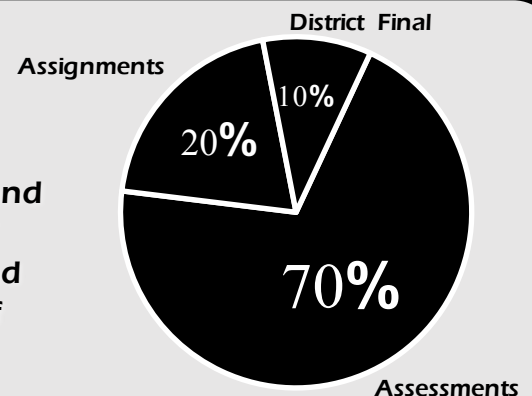


ASSESSMENTS & ASSIGNMENTS
