- Each essay must be typed. All essays should be typed with a 12 point font, double-spaced, and normal margins.
   This should be turned in as a final draft; you should proofread before you turn it in.
- All sources should be cited. This essay should be in your own words, if I can find parts of your essay online or
  in a book, it is plagiarized. Plagiarism will result in a 0 on the assignment.
