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## **\*\*DUE DATE FOR FABRIC/SUPPLIES**

7<sup>th</sup> grade FACS students will be making a pillowcase as part of the Clothing & Textiles Unit. Supplies for the pillowcase will be provided by school or students may purchase their own fabric and supplies. If you choose to purchase your own supplies, it's important that you have your fabric and supplies by the due date!

## Supplies needed:

- 3/4 yards of a tightly woven fabric cotton or cotton blend. DO NOT purchase knitted, silky, polar fleece, metallic or plaid fabrics. Flannel is ok. This is for the body of the pillowcase.
- **1/3 yard of a tightly woven fabric** cotton or cotton blend (same as above). This is for the cuff/trim on the top of the pillowcase.
- % Thread –One small spool of matching ALL PURPOSE or DUAL PURPOSE thread. **DO NOT** purchase button-hole, embroidery, guilting or carpet thread.

All students please bring 50 cents for a bobbin deposit. If you don't lose your bobbin, you will get your 50 cents back at the end of the unit.

OPTIONAL SUPPLIES (We have these items available for students to borrow if you chose not to purchase them.)

- $\gg$  Pins one box of straight pins beaded end pins work the best. A pin cushion is recommended to keep your pins organized.
- <sup>≫</sup> Seam ripper
- <sup>≫</sup> Hem/sewing gauge
