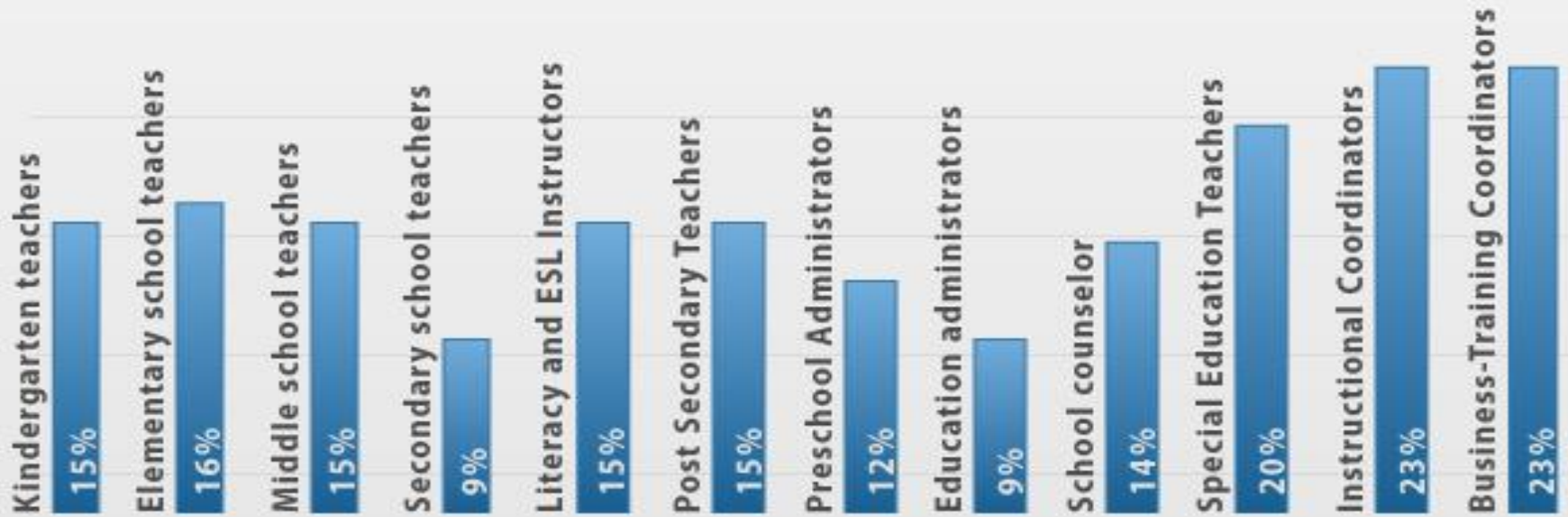

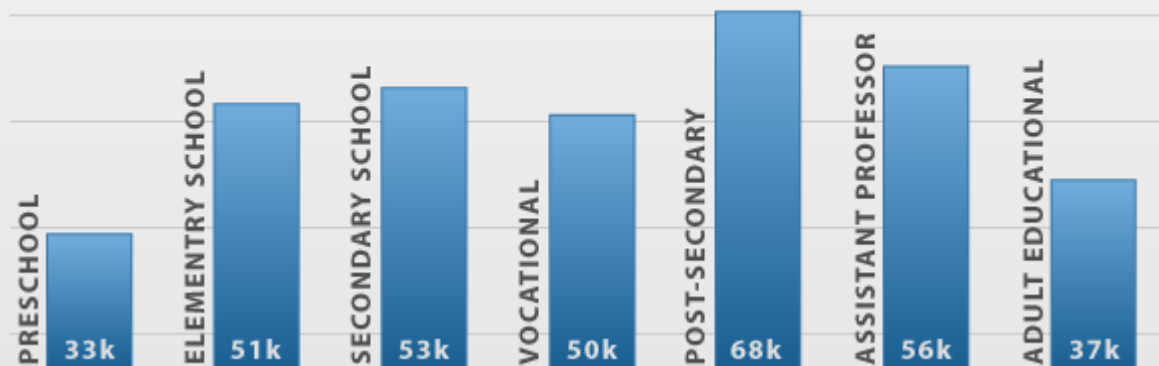
GROWTH FORECAST FOR CAREERS IN THE EDUCATIONAL INDUSTRY
