### **October 1, 2022 Enrollment Report**

The October 1 report is an accounting of the annual projection cycle which uses a number of assumptions, processes and data sources.

Attached is the October 1, 2022 enrollment counts report. The report includes:

### **Total Enrollment**

The total K-12 enrollment summary (page 1) shows an overall increase of 11 students from 2021 to 2022. The October 1 count shows 306 fewer students than originally projected.

### **Compared to projected**

#### **Elementary**

- Kindergarten enrollment has 47 less students than projected.
- Grades 1-5 are up 132 students from projected.
- K-5 counts were 249 students less than projected

#### **Middle School**

- The middle schools showed a decrease from projection, down 96 students.

#### **High School**

- There are 295 less students than projected at the high schools.

### **Compared to last year's Oct 1**

#### **Elementary**

- Kindergarten counts decreased by 47 students from the previous year.
- Grades 1-5 count increased by 381 students from the previous year.
- The K-5 elementary count increased by 334 students from the previous year.

#### **Middle School**

- The middle school count decreased by 45 students from the previous year.

#### **High School**

- The high school student count decreased by 278 students from the previous year.

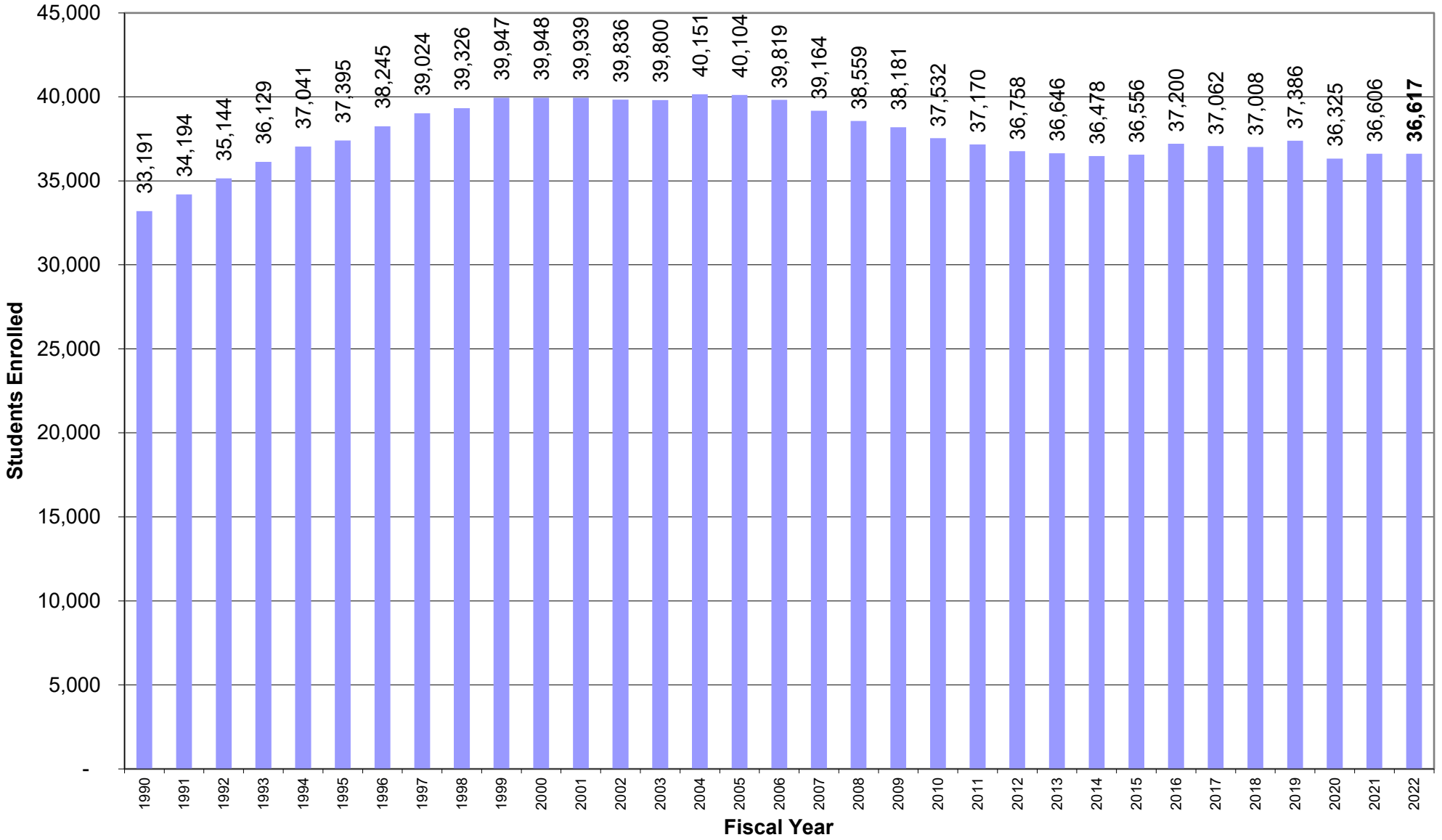

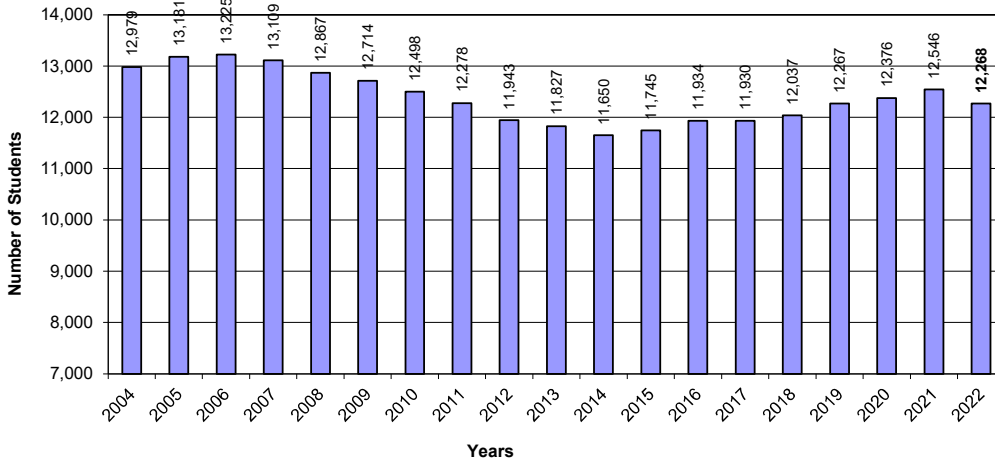


**Secondary Enrollments Grades 6 - 12

**Middle School Grades 6 - 8 Enrollments 2004 - 2022**

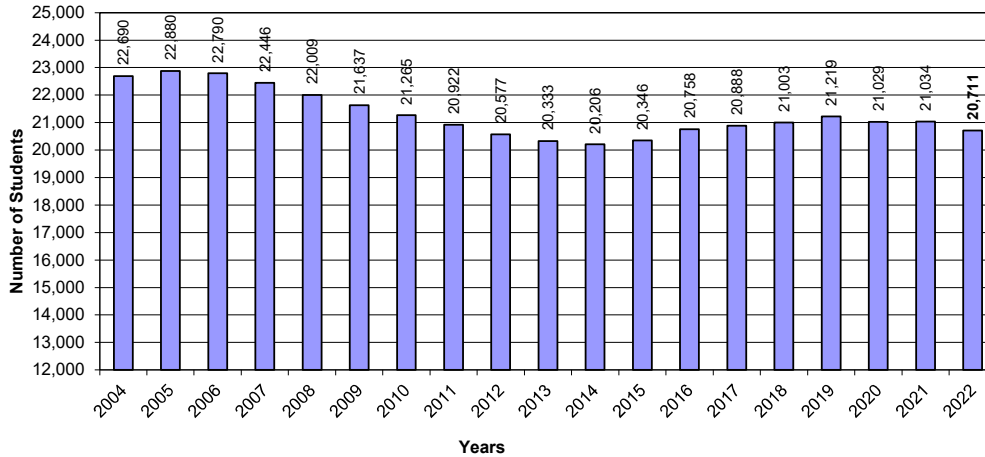


**High School Grades 9 - 12 Enrollments 2004 - 2022**

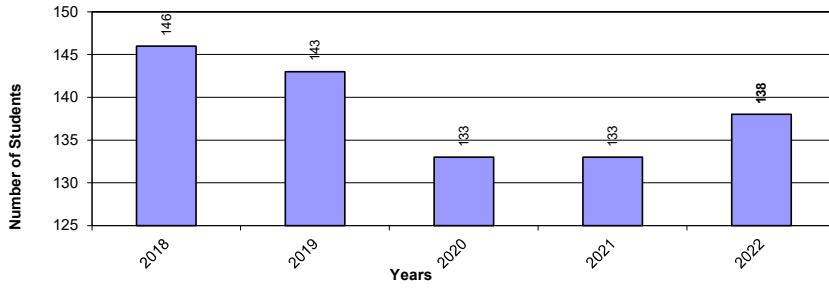

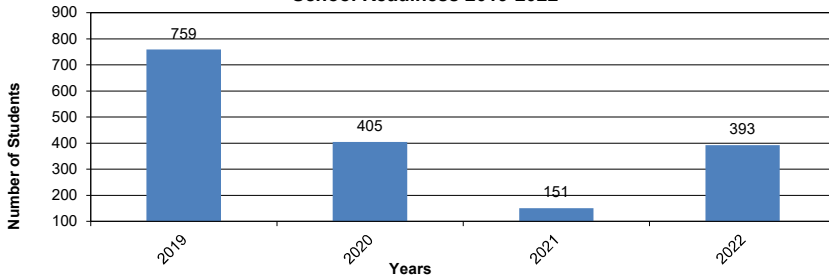
**KR Preschool Plus 2018 - 2022**



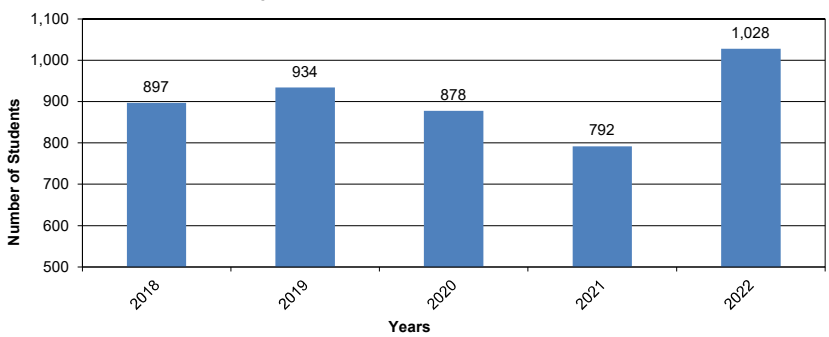
**K Readiness 2019-2022**



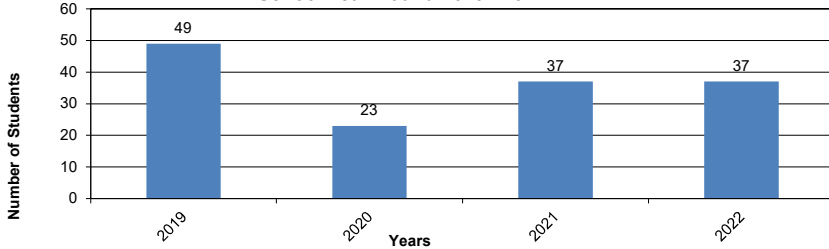
**School Readiness 2019-2022**
