CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT



The purpose of the Andover Clay Target Club is to promote youth shooting sports, provide a positive, safe, and fun atmosphere, provide athletes with a memorable experience, and develop skills that can be used well into adulthood. Due to the nature of our sport, we are bound by a stricter moral and behavioral code. As such, we are responsible for conducting ourselves in a manner above and beyond those who do not participate with our club. If you choose to be involved in the club, you and your parent/guardian need to read our code of conduct and be willing to abide by our team policies. We must also abide by the policies of the MN High School Clay Target League. The policies can be found at MNClayTarget.com.

Every team member has a duty to represent themselves, the team, and the school in the best manner possible. This applies to behavior both in and out of school and at any shooting club. WE are expected to avoid situations where we may be accused of wrongdoing.

In school discipline problems WILL remain in school, unless the discipline results in expulsion from school or violates the MSHSL rules where dismissal from the team is warranted.

The following violations may also result in suspension or dismissal from the team. All issues will be investigated in a fair and equitable manner.

1. Unsafe handling of a firearm or violating gun safety rules and regulations.
2. Missing our regular scheduled shooting time without prior consent from a coach.
3. Leaving the range prior to all squads having completed their rounds on your assigned field without the consent of the coaching staff.
4. Breaking of shooting club's rules or requirements.
5. Harassment or Threats (verbal, physical, sexual, etc.) of any Andover Club member (student, coach, staff member), students, coaches or staff members of other teams or shooting club staff or members.
6. Using illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.
7. Any act which the coaching staff views as reflecting in a negative manner on the club or school.
8. Inappropriate electronic communication and use of social media.
9. Abide by MN State High School League attire guidelines.

In addition, we agree to:

1. Meet all team mandated deadlines as communicated by the coaching staff.
2. Treat the coaching staff with respect and follow any instructions they may give without question or delay.
3. Listen to and/or carefully read all team communications and act on them accordingly.
4. Follow volunteer requirements.
5. Wear team issued shooting vests. (Waived for new fall athletes.)

Violation of the above policies or MSHSL Rules and Policies could result in dismissal from the team or league.

Registration and Communication Procedures



Registration Procedures

1. Complete and turn in the registration form along with your payment
- 2. New Athletes**
 - a. Go to claytargetgo.com
 - b. Click on "Athlete Management System"
 - c. Create a new account using team id: anr927
 - d. Follow the instructions to set up your profile
- 3. Existing Athletes**
 - a. Go to claytargetgo.com
 - b. Click on "Athlete Management System"
 - c. Log in and verify the email listed in your profile is correct
4. The team will take your registration and upload it to the claytargetgo.com site
5. The email in your profile will receive a message from claytargetgo.com instructing you to complete registration with the league.
6. Click on the link in the email and you will be directed to submit payment to the league for the season. If you do not complete this step, you will be on the team but none of your scores will count towards the league and you will not be able to compete in any state or championship tournaments.
7. Once league payment is completed, the email in your profile will receive an email confirming your participation in the MN High School Clay Target League.

Communication Procedures

1. Download the GroupMe app
2. Set up an account using the same information listed on your registration form
3. You will be added to contact list associated with the appropriate competition season
4. Messages, calendars, documents, and updates will be sent via GroupMe once registration is complete.
5. Initial season announcements will be sent via email and GroupMe.
